The Bill amending the *Environmental Protection Act 1994* is based upon science that would appear, given Professor Peter Ridd's expert opinion, to not be subject to rigorous scientific scrutiny and critical analysis, which calls in to question the reliability of the science.

The Premier should seek transparency of all procedures and methodologies of all research to ensure that the science the State Government is relying upon is reliable.

Agriculture is a vital part of the Queensland economy, employing some 63,000 people and contributing more than \$20 billion annually, and it is incumbent upon the Premier and the State Government to satisfy themselves of the reliability of the science before the Bill is passed into law by the State Government.
